DISCOVER THE NEW RUG COLLECTIONS THAT CELEBRATE CRAFTSMANSHIP AND NATURAL MATERIALS. UNDYED WOOL, LUXURIOUS CASHMERE, AND SUBTLE DESIGNS MAKE UP A SELECTION THAT BRINGS WARMTH AND TIMELESS ELEGANCE TO YOUR INTERIORS.





The **Além Tejo** collection by **Ferreira de Sá** draws from the cultural and material identity of the region that shares its name: endless plains, whitewashed façades, cork oak forests, agricultural mosaics, and the soothing rhythm of rural life. Each rug takes inspiration from a tangible reference — a stone wall, cork bark, or a field seen from above — to express its own rhythm, relief, and presence. The collection is crafted from undyed natural wool, a renewable and biodegradable fiber that reveals its authentic shades of white, beige, and soft grey. Subtle touches of jute and linen add firmness and texture. This choice of local, natural fibers reflects a sustainable approach, respectful of both the environment and regional craftsmanship. Under the artistic direction of Jessy Van Durme and through the photography of Piet-Albert Goethals, the collection comes to life in its place of origin. The images reveal the rugs in situ, in natural dialogue with the landscapes of Alentejo.

Like a freehand drawing of lines, *Maps* by Serge Lesage sketches an imaginary territory, a dialogue between planes and volumes. The natural shades – soft green, amber, and earthy notes – infuse the composition with warmth and harmony, while maintaining a timeless elegance. Made from New Zealand wool, Maps reveals the full subtlety of artisan work: its two pile heights create a vibrant texture, while each line is sculpted into the material to enhance its depth. Between geometric rigor and the poetry of the line, this rug stands out as a graphic work that is both structuring and delicate.
