## Emotion at the heart of creation

As a consequence of the uncertainties that define our era, decoration no longer aims merely to impress visually and rack up likes on social media; it seeks to be endearing, comforting, and composed of pieces imbued with emotion. In their collections, the maisons of Paris Déco Off&Home fully embrace this sentimental dimension. For instance, **Art & Floritude's** floral chandeliers appear gently patinated by time and history.

The irregularities inherent in handcrafted work are skillfully highlighted by Belgian maisons such as **Domani**, specializing in terracotta pottery, and **Floriane Bande Interior Design**, with its hammered bronze chandeliers. Meanwhile, **House of Hackney** infuses its retro wallpapers with all the charm of the countryside.

The creators are in harmony with this vision, celebrating the vintage spirit, such as decorator and gallery owner **Rose Uniacke**, and the British maison **Ochre**, guided by the sensitivity of designers Joanna Bibby and Harriet Maxwell Macdonald.



## "Cuddly" materials for winter

The time for cocooning has arrived. Our interiors transform into winter dens, playing with warm, natural materials: leather coverings from **Studio Art**, the plush velvets and wools of **C&C Milano**, and handwoven cashmere, silk, vicuña, and Tibetan wool throws and rugs from **CMO Paris**. Meanwhile, **Höpke Textiles'** "Chalet Deluxe" collection emphasizes soft microfibers and boucle fabrics in organic hues. Maisons **Dedar** and **Casamance** offer the cozy opulence of faux fur that feels more real than ever, with **Dedar's** "Nonstop Ethereal Bliss" models (in mohair and cotton) and **Casamance's** "Laponie." For accessories, **Nobilis** presents the "Cheyenne" cushion, reminiscent of white wolf fur, and the "Mouton" model in brown suede with a reversed leather look and long-pile ecru velvet.
